

Community Group Questions 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1

Head

- Read 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1
- What stands out to you from this passage? Why does this stand out to you?
- What does Paul mean when he says, “all things are lawful, but not all things are helpful”?
- Why are Christians called to seek the good of their neighbor instead of their own good?
- What instructions did Paul give to the people in regard to eating food sold in the meat market?
- What outcome should Christians seek in all the decisions that they make? (see verses 31-33)

Heart:

- Why do we often struggle to consider the good of others in our decisions?
- What steps can we take to ensure our actions are helpful and build others up?
- Why do we fail to think about God’s glory in all the things that we do?
- Why does God deserve all of the glory? (Give them the GOSPEL!!)
- In view of God’s glory and looking out for good of others, how is God calling you to reconsider your future actions and decisions? Give specific examples.

Hands

- Read verses 10:23-11:1 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
