Head

- How do we see the design of authority and order within marriage?

Heart:

- Why is authority and order so important?
- Why do we struggle to embrace the order and authority God has designed for our lives?
- How are your words, actions, and thoughts challenging God's authority and order?
- How is God calling you to humbly embrace this order? (your personal relationship with God, marriage, workplace, family, church, etc.)

Hands

- Read verses 11:2-16 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
