

Community Group Questions 1 Corinthians 13

Head

- Read 1 Corinthians 13
- What stands out to you from this passage? Why does this stand out to you?
- How does Paul describe the importance of love in verses 1-3?
- What characteristics does Paul use to define love? (verses 4-7)
- Why does Paul want the church to understand that love never ends?
- How is Paul calling them to think like men and women and not children?

Heart:

- Why is love so crucial when we use the spiritual gifts God has given to us?
- Why do we often disconnect the importance of love when we use of our spiritual gifts?
- Read verses 4 through 7 again and reflect on Jesus' love towards you. How does the love of Jesus impact the way you love others?
- Do you love the people around you with the type of love that is mentioned in these verses? Why or why not?
- How is God calling you to truly love the people in your life and in this church?

Hands

- Read chapter 13 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
