

## Community Group Questions 1 Corinthians 14:1-25

### Head

- Read 1 Corinthians 14:1-25
- What stands out to you from this passage? Why does this stand out to you?
- How does speaking in tongues benefit the church?
- Why is it important when one speaks in tongues in the church gathering that someone interprets?
- How does prophecy benefit the church?
- Why does Paul particularly want the people to desire to have the gift of prophecy?

### Heart:

- Why is it so important for us to understand and use the gift of tongues correctly?
- How can the misuse of tongues cause harm within the church? How have you experienced this in your own life?
- What is the purpose of order within the church gathering?
- Why is it important for us to have a solid biblical understanding when dealing with the gift of prophecy?
- How do these gifts remind us that the Kingdom of God is here?
- What steps can you take to better grow in your relationship with God and the understanding of the gifts that he has given to you?

### Hands

- Read chapter 14:1-25 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
- Pray
