- Why does Paul remind the church that God is not a God of confusion but of peace?
- What should Christians posture be towards speaking in tongues and prophesy?

Heart:

- Are you more inclined to abuse the spiritual gifts or neglect them? How is God calling you to be more biblical in your conduct of the gifts?
- Why is order and peace within the worship gathering so important?
- Why do we often struggle to submit to God's order and design in our lives?
- What has been the biggest challenge and encouragement for you as we have studied
 I Corinthians 12 through 14?
- How has God used these chapters to deepen your relationship with him?
- How can this community group continue to grow together in our understanding and practice of the spiritual gifts that God has given to us?
