- How are Christians called to care for other Christians with a weaker conscience? (verses 9-13)

Heart:

- Why do we often struggle to think about others when making decisions?
- Why is it important to remember knowledge and love in decision making?
- In Corinth, eating food offered to idols could be a stumbling block to Christians. What are some of the potential stumbling blocks in our culture? In your own life?
- In light of this passage, how is God calling you to rethink the decisions you are making?

- Read verses 8:1-13 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
