### Head

- Read 1 Corinthians 9:1-26
- What stands out to you from this passage? Why does this stand out to you?
- How does Paul defend his calling to the church at Corinth?
- What does Paul mean when he says he has become all things to all people?
- How does Paul challenge the Corinthians to run the race God has given them?

### Heart:

- What position has God given you responsibility over in the church and in society?
- Why do we often struggle to find our identity and worth in the positions that we hold?
- How can you use the position you are in today in a way that honors God and cares for others?
- What do you need to do or change in your practices that will help you to run the race of life with a Christ-centered purpose?

### Hands

- Read verses 9:1-26 again. How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
