

Community Group Questions Hebrews 6:13-20

Head

- Read Hebrews 6:13-20.
- What stands out to you from this passage? Why does this stand out to you?
- What is the significance of God's oath in this passage?
- Why does the author describe our hope as "an anchor of the soul"?

Heart

- Why do we need hope? Or how are you in need of hope today?
- What are some things that you have hoped in or are hoping in that have failed you? (Family, friends, marriage, job, sex, money, esteem, alcohol, control, etc)
- Why do you think these things eventually always let us down?
- Why is Jesus a better hope? [Check out v. 19: "a hope that goes behind the curtain" = access to God = eternal rest/joy/satisfaction/healing/peace]
- What would your life actually look like if you connected your anchor to (put your hope in) Jesus?
- How does God's oath and promises encourage you to do this?

Hands

- How is God asking you to respond today? (Is there a promise to believe; a sin to be confessed; a command to be obeyed?)
- How can we as your community help you respond the way God has called you to respond?
- Pray → Reread 6:17-18

¹⁷ So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he guaranteed it with an oath, ¹⁸ so that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope set before us.

Praise: Spend some time praising God for making gracious promises and always keeping them..

Confession/Lament: Tell God why you are in need of strong encouragement today...

Petition: Ask God for strength and grace to flee to Jesus for our refuge and to hold fast to him this week...
